Public Notice Attention all Students and Parents! Admission Offer and Demand of Donations other than the Declared Fee by the Private Sector Medical Colleges

Dated: 18-01-2023

This is with reference to ongoing admissions for the session 2022-23, it has come to the knowledge of Pakistan Medical Commission that some of the Private Sector Medical Colleges are demanding donations other than the declared fee structure from the students and their parents which is sheer violation of PMC Act 2022. As per the Subsection 7 of section 19 of PMC Act 2020:

All medical and dental colleges shall, at least three months prior to initiating the annual admissions process, publicly declare the fixed tuition and all ancillary fee structure on an annual basis for the entire program of study in which the students are seeking enrollment and which fee structure shall not be enhanced during the students period of enrollment at the college. No medical or dental college shall seek, demand or receive from a student or a student's family, directly or indirectly, any donations or other payment prior to or at the time of admission or thereafter during the period of the students continuing enrollment at the college whether as consideration for grant of admission or otherwise.
