## **“NOTICE TO ALL MEDICAL AND DENTAL COLLEGES”**

**(20<sup>th</sup> Sep 2021)**

It has been brought to the notice of the National Medical Authority, Pakistan Medical Commission, that some institutions are demanding tuition fees for the next year to be paid in advance this year, failing which the institution is set to take action against the students.

PMC would like to make it clear that such a demand and actions against students are unlawful and must be stopped with immediate effect.

Institutions are directed to ask for fees only after the professional examination is concluded and the result is declared. Fees for the next session can be asked from only those students who have passed the professional examination.

Institutions must retract such demands and publicly display the retraction on their websites immediately failing which action will be taken according to the law.
