Dear Prof. Mulazim Hussain Bhukari,

This is in reference to the advertisement of the Joint Admission committee, Azad Government of the state of Jammu and Kashmir. This is to inform you of the errors in the announcement which need to be corrected immediately.

- 1.1 **Eligibility criteria**; Your announcement states that total marks and obtained marks of three subjects should be mentioned by "fresh applicants" only. Please refer to the issued policy on PMC website. The above condition for merit calculation applies to all applicants having qualified in this or previous year.
- 1.2 In para 1 (ii), Please note that ALL students, foreign or Pakistani must have qualified the PMC MDCAT 2021 or MDCAT 2020, subject to the equivalenced marks notified by PMC. Furthermore, SAT-II or any other exam (e.g. International MCAT) cannot replace the mandatory condition of qualifying the MDCAT.

Please make the changes in your announcement immediately for the admissions to the session 2021-2022.
